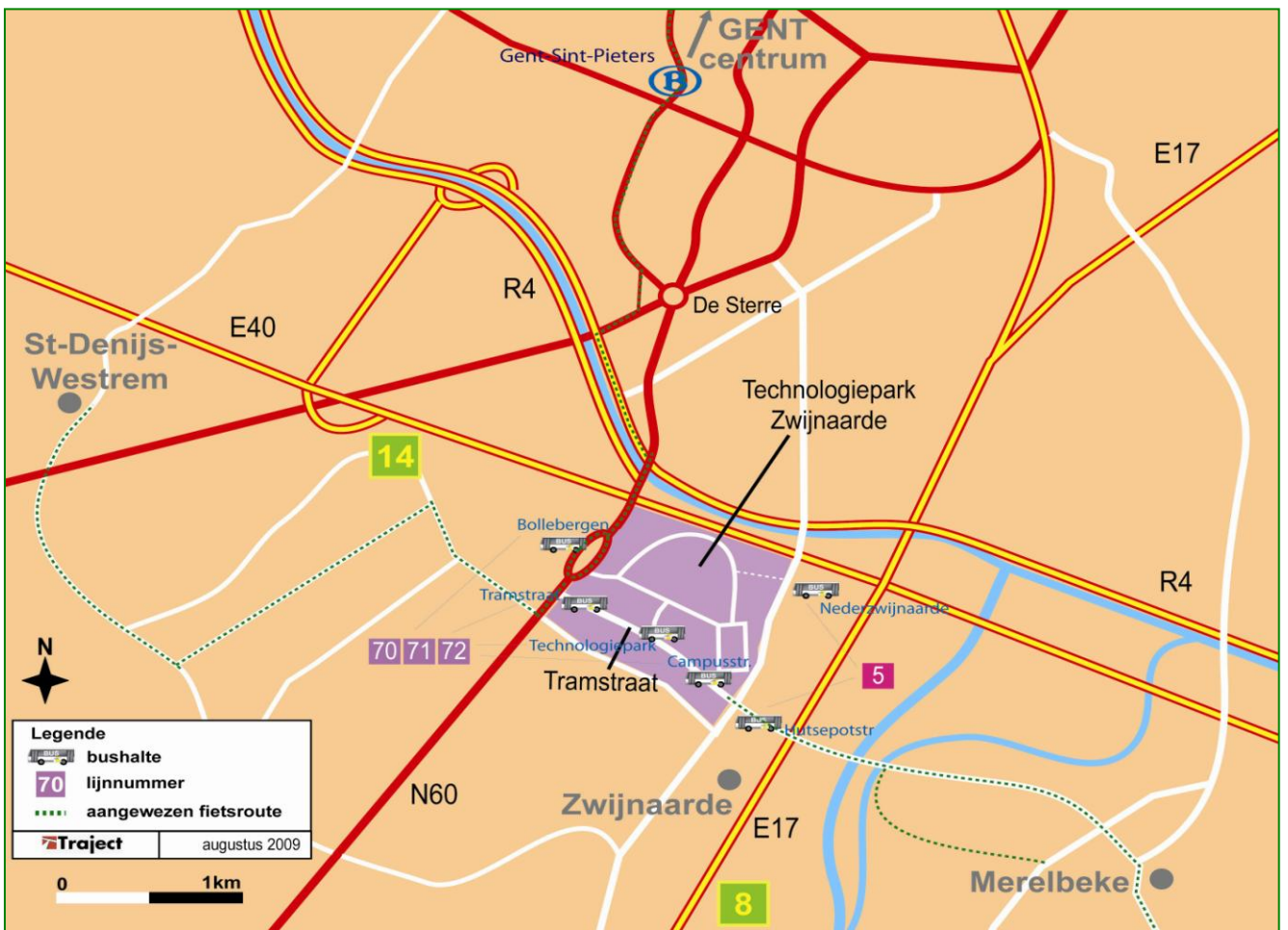
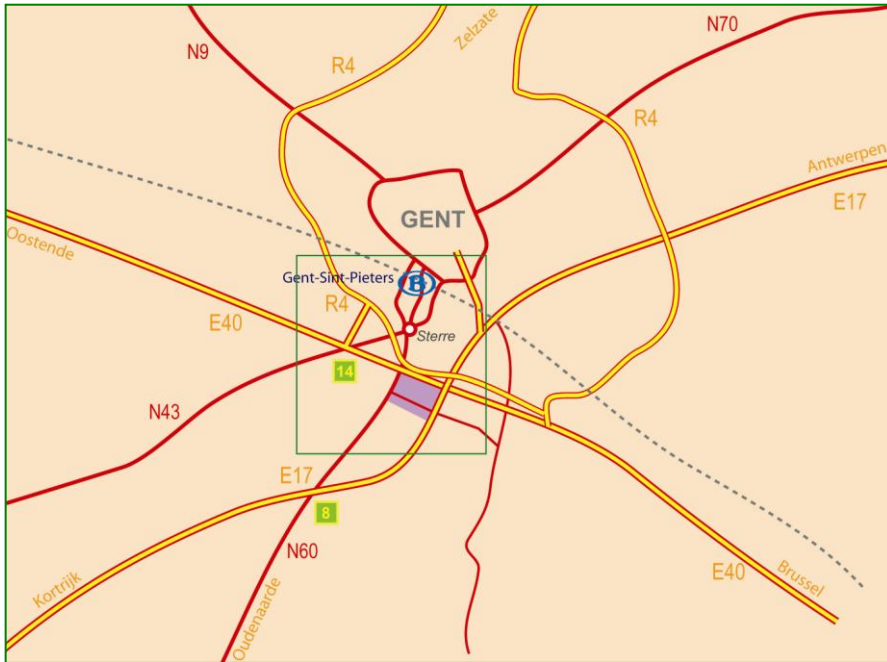


Accessibility company sites Technologiepark Zwijnaarde / Tramstraat





## By bike

The company site Technologiepark / Tramstraat is safely accessible from different directions. From the Ghent main railway station Sint-Pieters there is a safe and comfortable cycling route with cycling lanes away from the road along the Voskenslaan and Oudenaardsesteenweg (N60). The most important difficulty, De Sterre, can be avoided if considered necessary by using the Maaltebruggestraat and R4 (until the Oudenaardsesteenweg). Also from other directions there are plenty of cycle friendly routes to the site Technologiepark / Tramstraat available.

## By public transport

The main railway station Gent-Sint-Pieters is situated at more or less 3 kilometers from the site Technologiepark / Tramstraat. Every fifteen minutes there is a bus (nrs 70-71-72) between the railway station and the Technologiepark / Tramstraat. During the construction works at Gent-Sint-Pieters, these buses leave from the front side of the station (Maria Hendrikaplein). The east side from the Technologiepark is also served every thirty minutes by bus, line 5 (stops at main square Gent-Zuid).

## Shuttle bus Max Mobiel

The Max Mobiel shuttle bus (for employees) is available during the morning and evening peak hours and drives two times between the main railway station Gent-Sint-Pieters and the different companies situated in the Technologiepark / Tramstraat. In the morning the shuttle bus leaves at 8h and 8h15 at Gent-Sint-Pieters. In the evening, the return is foreseen at 17h and 17h25. Travelling time is 12 minutes. Persons wanting to use Max Mobiel have to reserve in advance. One important detail: the employer himself has to be associated with Max Mobiel. A drive there and back costs 3 euros.

## By car/truck

E40 – coming from Brussels or Bruges:

Take exit 14 – Gent-Expo at the E40. Drive past IKEA and follow the R40 in the direction of Zwijnaarde until the exit N60-Oudenaarde. You find the site Technologiepark / Tramstraat a bit further along the N60. You can enter the Tramstraat or Technologiepark across the roundabout.

E17 – coming from Antwerp or Kortrijk:

Take exit 8 – De Pinte / Nazareth and follow the N60 in the direction of Gent. After more or less 4 kilometers you can find the company site at your right side.
